#### **STABEX '95 VACCINE PROGRAMME**

Vaccine orders are still being processed and we urge all farmers to collect their VDA forms and vaccines from Fivet Animal Health as soon as possible.

PLEASE WILL ALL FARMERS NOTE THAT DUE TO CFU CLOSING FROM  $20^{TH}$  DECEMBER 2010 Until  $3^{RD}$  JANUARY 2011 THE LAST DATE FOR ACCEPTANCE OF VACCINE APPLICATION FORMS UNDER THE VACCINE PROGRAMME WILL BE <u>DECEMBER  $10^{TH}$  2010 at 1.00P.M.</u> TO ENABLE THESE FORMS TO BE PROCESSED TIMEOUSLY PRIOR TO SHUT DOWN. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED AND THIS IS THE FINAL DATE FOR SUBMISSIONS OF APPLICATIONS FOR VACCINES UNDER THE STABEX '95 VACCINE PROGRAMME.

NADF is circulating a form via e-mail for completion by those farmers who have benefited under the vaccine programme to enable us to try to evaluate the success of the programme. We will also have hard copies available at the office, so if you are dropping in to CFU, please could you fill one out. Hardcopies will also be given to ZFU and ZCFU for distribution.
