IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources Management has, in terms of section 129A of the Parks and Wildlife Act [Chapter 20:14], as read with section 97(1) of the Parks and Wildlife (General) Regulations, 1990, published in Statutory Instrument 362 of 1990, approved the following by-laws made by the Parks and Wildlife Management Authority—

- 1. These by-laws may be cited as the Parks and Wildlife Management Authority (Tariff of Fees) By-laws, 2013.
- 2. The Schedule sets out the tariff of fees payable by resident and non-resident in Zimbabwe in respect of the services and facilities specified therein.
- 3. The Schedule to the Parks and Wildlife Management Authority (Tariff of Fees) By-laws, 2007, published in Statutory Instrument 94 of 2007, is repealed and the following is substituted—

"SCHEDULE

#### PART I

### A. DAY ENTRIES

 NB: All charges in this document include 15% Value Added Tax (VAT) and 2% tourism levy for locals where applicable and 2% tourism levy for non-resident clients.

#### Note-

- Day rates for non-tour operators' clients cover single entry into a park.
   Visitors who exit before the day expires will be required to pay for re-entry on the same day.
- 2. Tour operator clients will be allowed re-entry on production of copies of pre-submitted lists and identification details relating to entering clients, except for Rainforest. Private visitors and Tour Operators' clients for Mana Pools, Gonarezhou and Rainforest will pay a daily conservation fee.
- Three employees of a tour operator are entitled free access per entry and camping.

- Rafting Operators will be allowed 5 employees free entry.
- Persons resident in Zimbabwe shall be charged the equivalent of the fees charged for persons not resident in Zimbabwe unless they produce positive identification of their Zimbabwean residence.
- 6. Visitors accommodated in Parks facilities and those entering and continuously staying on a water body shall pay a single day entry/River usage fees to cover up to 5 days and a daily overnight fees. River usage fees/person will only be charged where entry fees are not enforceable.
- 7. Resident pensioners above 60 years to pay 50% on entry fees subject to production of Zimbabwean citizen identification documents.
- 8. Children-
  - (a) all children who are between 6 and 12 years old will pay entry fees as in the entry fees Schedule.
  - (b) all children under 6 years old will not pay entry fees.
- Teachers on educational tours with pre-school children shall pay 50% of adult conservation fees, while the bus shall pay the full amount.
- Secondary school children and teachers on educational tours shall pay 50% of the adult's conservation and river usage fees.
- 11. Primary school children on educational tours shall pay US\$1,00 per child and the teachers shall pay 50% of the adult rate.
- 12. Pre-school children on educational tours shall pay US\$0,50/person as entry fees.
- 13. For all 50% discounts on entry fees, if the client has no coin, children's rates as in the entry fees Schedule will apply.

- 3. The fee for release of impounded kapenta rig shall be US\$2000,00 for locals and US\$4000,00 for non-residents.
- 4. Charge for release of impounded beast per beast per day shall be US\$2,00.

- 2. For any loss or damage of property is the current replacement value.

Note.—The Authority may waive the above charges, where in its opinion, conservation interests are at stake or life is threatened.".
