

Supreme Court (Miscellaneous Appeals and References)  
(Amendment) Rules, 2013 (No. 2)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Justice, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs has, in terms of section 34(4) of the Supreme Court Act [*Chapter 7:13*], approved the following rules of court made by the Chief Justice in terms of subsection (1) of that section—

1. These rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Miscellaneous Appeals and References) (Amendment) Rules, 2013 (No. 2).

2. The Supreme Court (Miscellaneous Appeals and References) Rules, 1975, published in Rhodesia Government *Gazette* Notice No. 449 of 1975, is amended in rule 4 (“Time within which notice to be given”) by the insertion of the following subrule, the existing rule becoming subrule (1)—

“(2) An appeal from a decision of the Labour Court in terms of section 92F (“Appeals against decisions of Labour Court”) must be delivered and filed in the Supreme Court no later than fifteen days from the grant of leave to appeal by the President of the Labour Court who made the decision or, where such leave is refused, within fifteen days from the grant of leave by a Judge of the Supreme Court.”.
