



## PRESS STATEMENT

BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ZIMBABWE

The Minister of Agriculture, Mechanisation and Irrigation Development, in terms of the Control of Goods Act Chapter 14:05, SI 350 Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Agriculture) Order 1993, wishes to announce and inform all stakeholders that all running Import and Export permits issued by the Ministry have been cancelled and recalled for replacement with immediate effect. All holders of subsisting cancelled Import and Export permits are required to surrender them to the Ministry for prompt replacement with the newly designed version.

New and replacement import and export permit applications will be processed at the Ministry of Agriculture, Mechanisation and Irrigation Development, No. 1 Borrowdale Road, Ngungunyana Building, Harare. The applications should be accompanied by relevant biosafety, sanitary and phyto-sanitary permits/certificates, as well as Ministry of Industry and Commerce licenses.

In order to facilitate movement of goods that are already at the borders and are being processed for entry or exit, scanned copies of the cancelled permits should be sent to [wmakotose@gmail.com](mailto:wmakotose@gmail.com) or [tirivangani@gmail.com](mailto:tirivangani@gmail.com) for authentication.

Importers and Exporters are strongly advised not to confirm and load consignments to the border before they have obtained all the necessary documents.
