Zambia Maize Flow Price Pitched At K70

Government finally announced the long awaited maize flow price for the 2014/15 season pegging it at K70. 00. This translates into a K5. 00 increment from last season's price which had been stuck at K65. 00 for four (4) farming seasons. Minister of Agriculture and Livestock, Hon. Wilbur Simuusa made the announcement in a ministerial statement read in Parliament on Friday morning 20th June , 2014.







The graph below shows fertiliser prices for selected districts as captured by ZNFU regional offices.




WHEAT Highlights


- Wheat futures in South Africa dropped to a 5-Month Low on Black Sea Imports. According to Reuters, it has become cheaper to import new-season Russian wheat than it is to buy local. Wheat for delivery in July dropped 0.9 percent to 3,790 rand (\$353) a metric ton by the midday close on the South African Futures Exchange on Thursday last week.
- In related news, South Africa is said to have imported 53,351 tons of wheat in the week to June 13 and that included 47,120 tons from the Ukraine and 20,066 tons from Russia according to the South African Grain Information Service on its website.
- The Chicago wheat futures for delivery in July settled at US\$ 233/MT this Monday morning 23rd June, 2014.
- Locally wheat prices are in the range of K2.4-2.8/KG. the graph below shows wheat price trends:

The Safex international soft red and hard red average wheat prices for last week settled at US\$233.16/MT and US\$307.52/MT respectively. Soft red prices fell dropped by 1.28 percent on average whilst hard red prices dropped by 0.19 percent when compared to the previous week. All prices are fob gulf.


SOYA BEANS

Highlights

- Dwindling Indian demand for palm oil may expand stockpiles in Indonesia and Malaysia, the biggest growers, and pressure palm oil prices which have already dropped 8.4 percent this year.
- Bloomberg reports that the Solvent Extractors' Association of India says shipments of crude and refined palm oils slid 14 percent to 647,756 metric tons last month from a year earlier, Crude soybean oil imports more than tripled to 174,209 tons, while sunflower oil purchases more than doubled to 178,753 tons.
- Zambia in the recent past also recorded increased importation of crude palm oil and the further drop in world prices could see the continued importation of the oil.
- Meanwhile, Chinese soybean imports may increase in June to as much as 7.5 million tons, a near record and up from 6.9 million tons at the same time last year, Oil World has said.
- The Chicago wheat futures for delivery in July settled at US\$ 524/MT this Monday morning 23rd June, 2014.
- On the local market, Soybeans prices on the local market remain average ranging between K1.8-2.75/Kg.

Last week's average international price of US No. 2 yellow soya beans on Safex settled at US\$543.68/MT,2.38 percent below the previous' week's average of US\$556.93/MT.



Maize

Highlights


- Maize futures in the U.S rose today extending a weekly gain on the backdrop of concerns that excessive rain in Midwest will cause crop conditions to deteriorate for the world's biggest grower and exporter. Maize for December delivery rose 0.8 percent to touch \$4.5725/bushel, the highest since June 6. Futures climbed 1 percent last week, the first increase since the period ended May 9.
- The Chicago maize futures for delivery in July settled at US\$ 180/MT this Monday morning 23rd June, 2014.
- On the domestic market, Maize prices hovered between K0.80-1.4/KG in the past week.



COTTON

Highlights

- Farmers and cotton stakeholders in Tanzania, represented by the Tanzania Cotton Growers Association (TACOGA), Tanzania Cotton Association (TCA), and the Tanzania Cotton Board (TCB) have agreed on a minimum price of Tsh750 (US\$ 0.446)/kg of cotton for the new marketing season that began on June 18, 2014, according to an East African Business Week report.
- Tanzania is expected to produce 250,000 tons for the ongoing cotton season 2014-15,in 2012-13, Tanzanian farmers produced around 360,000 tons of cotton, about 57 percent more than 255,000 tons produced in 2011-12.

BEEF

Highlights

- On the Namibian market, Grade A0 beef was trading in the range of R30—32.49 per Kg for the week ending 23rd June 2014 as captured by the meat board of Namibia.
- Beef prices on the New york market are still rising with market players attributing this to fewer animal available for sell .The CME live cattle price for August 2014 delivery as of 24th June settled at 148.20 cents/pound (US\$ 3.26/kg).
- On the domestic market, prices for standard beef traded higher in the week ending 20th may and were in the range of K14-20/kg, this is as captured by the ZNFU 4455 price information system.



Crude Oil


Highlights

- The Islamic insurgent in Iraq have continued influencing the international crude oil prices. By end of last week, Brent prices had hit a nine month high of US\$115/barrel but came down at the start of the new week as the market players became less anxious about the political situation in Iraq.
- By end of day Monday, Brent prices settled at US\$114.05/barrel while WTI futures at US\$106.1/barrel.




Poultry Industry Update Average Egg Prices


Average Day Old Chick Prices
