Industry Updates

Price Of Day Old Chicks On The Rise

Hybrid, one of Zambia's main hatchery operators recently increased the price of day old chicks, effective on the 7th of July 2014. The price of broilers has been increased by 5% while the layers have been increased by about 7.6%. The hatchery has attributed this price increase to the increase in the cost of production of the day old chicks.

However, there has been a general increase in the price of day old chicks from other hatcheries as well especially during the first half of the year when there seemed to be a shortfall in production and increase in demand.

Following these price increases, poultry farmers have expressed concern over the ever increasing cost of production in Zambia and expect the price of retail chickens increase in the short run.

FAO Food Price Index Plummets

Global food prices fell for a third consecutive month in June a decline mostly influenced by lower wheat, maize and palm oil prices that reflected ample supplies and improved global production prospects for these commodities, this is according to the Food and Agriculture organization. The FAO price index, which measures monthly price changes for a basket of cereals, oilseeds, dairy, meat and sugar, averaged 206.0 points in June, down 3.8 points or 1.8 percent from May and nearly 6 points (2.8 percent) below the June

2013 level.





Highlights


- The FAO raised their outlook on the global wheat crop in 2014/15 by 4 Million Metric Tonne from last month to 707 MMT. That increase came mostly on improved prospects in Brazil, the EU, India and Russia. They cut 2014/15 ending stocks however by 2 MMT to 180 Million tonnes, although that's still 6 Million Metric Tonnes up on 2013/14.
- The Chicago wheat futures for delivery in July settled at US\$ 220/MT on Friday afternoon 4th July, 2014.
- On the local Market, wheat prices are in the range of K2.4-2.8/Kg. The graph below shows wheat price trends:

The Safex international soft red and hard red average wheat prices for last week settled at US\$249.25/MT and US\$301.88/MT respectively. All prices are fob gulf.



Highlights


- The Chicago soybeans futures for delivery in July settled at US\$ 477/MT on Friday afternoon 04th July,2014, 2014.
- On the local market, soybeans prices have continued moving sideways with the current offer for the commodity still pegged at K2.75/Kg on the ZNFU 4455 market information system.

The average price for international US No. 2 yellow soya beans on Safex settled at US\$550.60/MT this week.



Maize Highlights

- The Zimbabwean grain millers and farmers representative organizations have come together in a bid to shore up the local maize producer price as well as either reduce or completely eliminate imports of maize meal from the region. There is concern that imports cheap from the region are depressing local maize prices in a development that is forcing farmers to quit production of the crop.
- The Grain Millers Association of Zimbabwe (GMAZ) and Zimbabwe Commercial Farmers Union (ZCFU) and the Commercial Farmers Union (CFU) are proposing the application of Surtax to ensure that imports glut of Maize meal is eliminated.
- Maize prices in Zimbabwe are currently around US\$220.00 per tonne.
- The Chicago Maize futures for delivery in December settled at US\$163.4/MT on Friday morning 4th July, 2014.


 Locally, the announcement of the maize floor price has not had a substantial pull effect on maize prices which remain sticky and averaging around K1.36/Kg for the week ending 04th July.


The average international price on Safex price of US No. 2 Yellow maize for last week settled at US\$195.29/MT lower than last week's average.


COTTONHighlights

- The Cotton Advisory Board (CAB) in India has forecasted India's cotton production for the ongoing season (October 2013-September 2014) to be at a record high of 39 million bales, according to a Business Standard report. In 2012-13 cotton season, the area under cotton was 11.98 million hectares, which fell to 11.73 million hectares this season, due to reduction in cotton sowing area in some states but the average cotton yield per hectare increased by 9 percent to 565.36 kg compared to the previous season offsetting the decrease in acreage.
- Higher ending stocks outside China and lower imports into China will put downward pressure on the international cotton prices in 2014-15, according to a statement by the International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC). world ending stocks are expected to rise by 6% to 21.4 million tons in 2014/15.
- The New York market cotton prices settled at 71.79cents/pound by end of day Friday as can be seen in the graph below:



Crude Oil Highlights

 Brent futures held steady around during the week 4thJuly, 2014 ending US\$111 a barrel on Friday on signs of an improving demand outlook, although the benchmark is still set to post its biggest weekly loss since early January as supply worries that have rattled oil markets for weeks recede as Libya prepares to resume exports from two terminals and amid speculation that Iraq's crude production will remain unaffected by violence.




Average Day Old Chick Prices

The graph below shows average prices of day old chicks for selected towns. Compared to the last week the prices have remained the same except for Chipata where the price of Hybrid Chicks has increased from ZMW 4.4 TO 4.95.Kabwe is Still posting highest price for Bokomo chicks at an average of ZMW5 while Mansa is posting high price for Hybrid day old chicks averaging ZMW4.7 per chick and Ross day old chick are costing ZMW 4.7 per bird.




Average Live Birds Prices

The graph shows the average live bird prices for selected districts. Compared to last week, the price of broilers in Lusaka has increased by about 8% but Lusaka remains the town with the lowest prices for broilers. Kabwe has registered a price reduction of about 16% for broilers and a 30% decrease in the price of village chickens. However Kabwe maintains the highest price for village chickens as was the case last week. Chipata has registered an increase in the price of broilers and a reduction in the price of village chickens, while Mongu has recorded an increase in the price of village chickens and a reduction in the price of broilers from ZMW30-ZMW32.5 and ZMW35-ZMW36 respectively.
