## **Swine Fever Hits Kabompo District**

Kabompo has become the latest district to record pig deaths due to African swine fever. The District Veterinary Office is still compiling data on the number of pigs have been killed by the deadly disease. Government has since effected a pig and pig products movement ban within a 250 kilometer radius, covering Kabompo, Zambezi and Chavuma Districts. Kabompo becomes the fifth district in North Western Province to have been affected by African swine fever this year.


# **WHEAT**


#### **Highlights**

- Statistics Canada cut the country's wheat harvest expectations this year to 27.70 million tonnes citing the loss of crops to excessive rains in the main Prairies production area. Canada Last year harvested a bumper 37.53 million tonnes of wheat. Analysts had expected a figure of 28.5m tonnes.
- Total UK wheat imports in 2013/14 were 2.21Million tonnes, second only to the record 2.96Mt imported in 2012/13. Within the EU, the main sources of UK wheat imports were Germany and Denmark, which accounted for 27% and 17% of all imports respectively.
- France, EU's top grower and exporter of wheat, has started importing wheat from Britain and Lithuania before the 2014/15 harvest due to poor grade crop being expected to harvest after rain damaged fields.
- Wheat for delivery in December settled at US\$204/MT on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2014 Morning.

#### Price trends

The Safex international soft red and hard red average wheat prices for last week settled at US\$218.97/MT and US\$263.25/MT respectively. All prices are fob gulf.

## **SOYA BEANS**

## **Highlights**

- Monsanto, the world's largest seed company expects to begin selling new soybean seeds resistant to a broader range of herbicides in 2016 pending regulatory approvals in major agricultural countries. According to the Wall Street Journal, Monsanto has sought U.S. Agriculture Department approval for the seeds since 2010.
- Soybeans for delivery in September settled at US\$422/MT on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2014 Morning.
- On the local market, soybeans prices remain in the range of K2-2.8/kg.

Last week's average international price of US No. 2 yellow soya beans on Safex settled at US\$477.25/MT, 0.94 percent below the previous' week's average of US\$492.78/MT. all prices are fob gulf.

#### Maize


#### **Highlights**

- Zimbabwe is said to have imported nearly 121 000 metric tonnes of genetically modified (GM) maize from South Africa between February and July this year, in contravention of the country's own bio safety laws. According to the Herald Business in Zimbabwe, Statistics obtained from South Africa's Department of Agriculture show that the imports were by three non-governmental organisations, Louis Dreyfus, Topfer International and GAPS.
- South Africa is likely to slightly raise its 2014 maize output forecast, a Reuter's survey showed on Friday to 14.031. The government's Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) last month said maize output for 2014 would rise to 14.017 million tonnes.
- Cuba's maize production is poised to increase this year on account of good weather and projected higher yields .harvesting is expected to start late in September.
- Maize for delivery in December on CME settled at US\$145/MT on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2014 Moring.

Locally, maize prices have entered into a bear market, with the highest price offer for the commodity pegged at K1.38/kg, this is as captured by the ZNFU 4455 price information system. FRA has also continued to make maize purchases.




## **COTTON** Highlights

- India could topple China as the world's largest cotton grower next year as farmers plant the biggest area ever, boosting production to near-record levels, according to the Cotton Association of India. The harvest is estimated at 39.63 million bales of 170 kg each, or 6.74 million tonnes, in the season starting October 1, the Association said in its first prediction for 2014-2015.
- China has released a warning to importers on the quality of cotton from Australia. According to Cotlook, 21.9 percent of Chinese imports from Australia since June 2014 did not reach the quality grade sold, significantly higher than the average unqualified ratio for the same grades from other origins (at 12.8 percent).
- Turmoil in South Africa's textile industry seems to have subsided with the workers ending their strike after being granted their 8.75 percent wage hike.
- The National Biotechnology Body of Zimbabwe has been quoted by international media to have told its parliament to push for the adoption BT cotton in an effort to increase the country's cotton production.
- The Cotlook 'A' index prices settled at 74.90 cents/pound (≈US\$1.75/Kg) on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 13:48hrs GMT.
- Cotton prices on the New York market were pegged at 66.18 cents/pound (≈US\$1.46/Kg) by end of day on Friday.


- While Iran's meat imports dropped by almost threefold due to the growth of its local meat industry, South Korea is expected to import more beef in 2015 as domestic numbers fall and prices rise.
- Foot-and-Mouth Disease has broken out in South Africa's Limpopo District, a key cattle rearing area in the north-east.
- On the Namibian market, weaners and heifers were auctioning for about R17.76/Kg and R14.52/kg respectively as at 18<sup>th</sup> August 2014. Meanwhile Class A1 beef in abattoirs was going for about R31-33.97/Kg on the same day.
- October 2014 delivery prices setlled at 147.55 cents/pound ( US\$ 3.25/kg) on, 25<sup>th</sup> August on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
- Local beef prices were trading in the range of ZMK13-20/kg, dressed weight, in the week ending 1<sup>st</sup> August 2014.
