SADC TO RECEIVE NORMAL RAINFALL DURING 2014/15 AGRICULTURAL SEASON

The Southern Africa Development Community (SADC) is expected to receive normal to above normal rainfall for the period October to December 2014. This is according to a statement from the eighteenth southern Africa regional climate outlook forum (sarcof-18) recently held in Namibia. The northernmost Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), northern Madagascar and Mauritius are however more likely to receive normal to below-normal rainfall. Between January and March 2015, the bulk of the region is forecast to receive normal to above normal rainfall except for the greater part of DRC, northernmost Angola and Mauritius which are likely to receive normal to below-normal rainfall.




The graph below shows fertiliser prices for selected districts as captured by ZNFU regional offices.



WHEAT

Highlights


- Algeria faces record wheat imports in 2014/15 as the country is postured to import up to 7.5million tonnes of the grain. The US Department of Agriculture bureau in Algiers said Algeria's wheat import needs may hit a record high, at a time of poor quality supplies from its default origin, France.
- The European Union during the previous week granted export licences for 852,000 tonnes of soft wheat, taking the total since the beginning of the 2014/2015 (July-June) season to 4.6 million tonnes, official data showed on Thursday.
- The General Authority for Supply Commodities (GASC) in Egypt bought its first French wheat at tender in nearly eight months, as offers from Russia, which has started strongly on its 2014-15 export campaign, rose out of competitiveness. GASC, bought 60,000 tonnes of French wheat whose export prospects this season have been clouded by rain damage to the quality of its harvest. The purchase reflected a drop in the offer price to \$240.40 a tonne.
- Germany's farm ministry lifted its domestic wheat harvest estimate to 27.94million tonnes, a rise of 11.7% from last year's 25.02 million tonne crop. Germany is the European Union's second biggest producer of wheat after France.
- Chicago Wheat for delivery in December was pegged at US\$193/MT Monday morning 8th Sept, 2014 morning.
- Wheat prices locally are pegged around US\$ 452/MT in Lusaka. The graph below shows wheat price trends:






Price trends



Highlights


- Indian soybean area planted has recorded a drop of 9 per cent during 2014 at 10.90 million hectares.
- The international grains council raised slightly its projection for soybeans production in 2014/15 from 304.1 million tonnes to 304.4 million tonnes.
- Chicago soybeans for delivery in November was pegged at US\$373/MT on Monday, 8th Sept, 2014 morning.
- The local price for soybeans has remained steady with the highest price offer for the commodity on the market still
 pegged at K2.8/Kg, this is as captured by the ZNFU 4455 price information system. The graph below show price trends




Maize Highlights

- The International Grains council in its latest grain market report raised by 4 million tonnes its forecast for global maize production in 2014/15 to 973 million metric tonnes from its July estimate of 969 million metric tonnes. The 2013/14 production was estimated at 982 million metric tonnes.
- The USDA in there quarterly report say they anticipate a drop in the value of US exports due to lower prices of maize, wheat, and soybeans. Maize exports are expected to drop to \$8.9 billion, due to strong crops throughout the world. Global supplies are expected to be plentiful, resulting in renewed export competition and weak prices, the report says.
- Chicago maize for delivery in December was pegged at US\$137MT on Monday morning 8th Sept, 2014 morning.
- Locally maize prices as captured by the ZNFU 4455 system ranged between K1-1.4/KG in the past week.

The average international price on Safex price of US No. 2 Yellow maize for last week settled at US\$174.97/ton,1.4 percent below the previous week's price of US\$177.46/ton. All prices are fob gulf.





COTTON

Highlights

• In a bid to boost the country's cotton production by reducing susceptibility to drought, the Swaziland Cotton Board is exploring the possibility of introducing genetically modified cotton in the country. The newly established big bend ginnery of Swaziland has ginned about 1,200 tons of cotton since April according to the cotton board. Swaziland's estimated 2014 cotton production is 2400 tons from an area of 4000 hectares.


- South Africa's seed cotton production for the 201/14 season is estimated to be higher than the previous season's output by 74 percent. The 2014 harvest is estimated at 24,936 metric tons by the country's cotton association.
- Locally, the cotton marketing season has effectively closed with prices hovering around K3.1/Kg. The higher prices experienced this season may see Zambia dedicate more hectares to the cotton crop.
- On 4th September 15:38hrs CAT, cotton prices on Cotlook were pegged at 74.95 cents/pound (≈US\$1.65/Kg).
- Cotton prices on the New York market ended trading on 4th September at US\$0.6545/pound (≈US\$1.44/Kg).



BEEF

Highlights


- With beef prices down by about 200 Euro's per head from last year on the Irish market, the farmers in Ireland are demanding for a supply chain response as farmers were taken the full blow of the financial hit. The beef site further stated that the farmers were calling for a strong live export so as to keep a balance in supplies.
- About 3 percent of Botswana's cattle in Zone 6 have measles according to a statement made by the Botswana meat commission on 1st September. Farmers' were being encouraged to curb the disease as measles affects the quality of meat and may affect the country's access to the European Union market.
- On the Namibian market, weaners and heifers were auctioning for about R17.68/Kg and R15.92/kg respectively as at 29th August 2014. Meanwhile Class A1 beef in abattoirs was going for about R31-33.97/Kg on 1st September 2014.
- October 2014 delivery prices setlled at 151.42 cents/pound (US\$ 3.33/kg) on, 25th August on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
- Local beef prices have edged upwards and were trading in the range of ZMK14-26.5/kg, dressed weight, in the week ending 5th September 2014.



POULTRY


AVERAGE DAY OLD CHICK PRICES

The graph below shows average prices of day old chicks for selected towns. The price of day old chicks has been stable the past two weeks in most towns except for Mansa where the price of Hybrid day old chicks increased from ZMW 4.73 to ZMW 4.95 and from ZMW4.8 to ZMW4.95 for Ross, representing 4.65% and 3.1% increase in price respectively. Meanwhile supply of day old chicks remains very stable in the market.




AVERAGE LIVE BIRDS PRICES

The graph below shows the selected average live bird prices in Lusaka, Choma, Kabwe, Chipata, Mongu and Mansa. The graph shows consumer preference for village chickens in all the towns that are displayed as is evident from the high price being charged for village chicken compared to broilers and layers. The price of village chicken in Mansa has taken an upswing from the ZMW45 charged two weeks ago to ZMW65 this week, representing a price increase of 44.4%. Kabwe has the second highest priced village chicken at ZMW61.67, also representing a dramatic 76.2% price increase from the ZMW35 charged two weeks ago. The price of village chicken in Lusaka, Chipata, Kasama, Choma and Mongu is ZMW51.67, 52.5, 45, 45 and 40 respectively. The price of layers have been relatively stable while the price of broilers in Lusaka and Mansa have dropped from ZMW33.4 to ZMW 32 and from ZMW35 to ZMW 32.5 representing 4.2% and 7% increase in price respectively.




AVERAGE EGG PRICES

The table below shows average prices of eggs in selected provincial centres around the country. The price of eggs per tray has remained relatively static in most towns except in Lusaka where the price has reduced from ZMW20.50 to ZMW20 representing 2.4% price reduction and Kabwe where the price has risen from ZMW21 to ZMW23 representing 9.5% price increase. Chipata is posting the highest price for a tray of eggs at ZMW26.5




AVERAGE FEED PRICES

The average feed prices have remained relatively stable during the course of the week. The graph below shows the average poultry stock feed prices with Lusaka posting the lowest prices in terms of feed compared to other towns. Kasama is posting the highest prices for all broiler feeds. The graph further shows that pullet feeds are generally lower than broiler feeds. No price statistics for pullet feeds have been captured for Kabwe while only layer mash prices were captured in Chipata.



AVERAGE WHOLE DRESSED CHICKEN PRICES

The graph below shows average prices of whole frozen chickens in the three chain stores around in Lusaka. Shoprite has the lowest priced chickens compared to Spar and Pick n' Pay. The average price of frozen whole chicken in Shoprite is ZMW17.72/Kg, with the lowest price going for ZMW15.49 /Kg and the highest pegged ZMW19.90/Kg. The lowest priced chicken in Spar is going for ZMW15.49 while the highest priced is going at ZMW20.70 per kg and the average price per Kg of frozen whole chicken in Spar is ZMW18.9 per kg. The average price of whole frozen chicken in Pick n' Pay is ZMW17.75/kg, with the lowest and highest priced chicken at ZMW17.50/Kg and ZMW17.99/Kg respectively.
