Customs and Excise (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2014 (No. 74)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Finance and Economic Development has, in terms of section 235 of the Customs and Excise Act [Chapter 23:02], made the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2014 (No. 74).
- 2. The Customs and Excise (General) Regulations, 2001, published in Statutory Instrument 154 of 2001 (hereinafter called "the principal regulations"), are amended in the proviso to section 124 (2), by the insertion after paragraph (c) of the following—
 - "(d) All foodstuffs of Tariff Headings listed below except where the Minister has directed the Commissioner-General to grant a rebate to specifically approved foodstuffs:
