- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$202.81/mt last week to US\$235.01/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$190.61/mt last week to US\$204.53/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT markets decreased from US\$175.03/mt and US\$150.94/mt last week to US\$172.57/mt and US\$150.78/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from US\$340.18/mt last week to US\$331.17/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT prices increased from US\$217.24/mt and US\$181.00/mt last week to US\$219.08/mt and US\$193.64/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX and US GULF soyabean prices decreased from US\$467.11/mt and US\$392.05/mt last week to US\$451.66/mt and US\$390.33 this week while the CBOT price increased from US\$357.14/mt last week to US\$361.41/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from US\$188.59/mt last week to US\$192.57/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from **USc68.60/Pound** last week to **USc69.55/Pound** this week.
