- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$235.01/mt last week to US\$234.46/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$204.53/mt last week to US\$202.76/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT markets increased from US\$172.57/mt and US\$150.78/mt last week to US\$173.66/mt and US\$151.02/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from US\$331.17/mt last week to US\$330.66/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT prices increased from US\$219.08/mt and US\$193.64/mt last week to US\$223.21/mt and US\$193.86/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabean prices increased from US\$451.66/mt, US\$390.30/mt and US\$361.41/mt last week to US\$455.53/mt, US\$395.63/mt and US\$365.81/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from **US\$192.57/mt** last week to **US\$208.20/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from **USc69.55/Pound** last week to **USc71.55/Pound** this week.
