TOBACCO

- ♣ As at 13 March 2015, 91 307 growers had registered compared to 96 436 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 13 March 2015 stood at 3,022,449 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.14/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 4,239,779 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.72/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$6.46 million compared to US\$11.53 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$223.64/mt last week to US\$215.71/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$203.39/mt last week to US\$201.07/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$173.36/mt and US\$150.15/mt last week to US\$175.53/mt and US\$151.17/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from US\$329.75/mt last week to US\$323.19/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$214.40/mt and US\$181.29/mt last week to US\$216.23/mt and US\$184.82/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX and US GULF soyabean prices decreased from US\$431.78/mt and US\$390.03/mt last week to US\$423.52/mt and US\$388.47/mt this week respectively while the CBOT market price did not change.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$204.32/mt last week to US\$198.27/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc70.15/Pound last week to USc67.25/Pound this week.
