The average price per kilogramme for commercial, bulling heifers, weaner steers, long weaner heifers and feeder steers went up while the average price for economy, manufacturing, weaner heifers, long weaner steers and communal weaner steers went down.

TOBACCO

- As at 06 March 2015, 90 701 growers had registered compared to 95 258 who had registered same time last year. Please note that last week's figures were overstated.
- The tobacco marketing season has commenced.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 5 March 2015 stood at 594,791 kgs sold at an average price of US\$1.53/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 940,864 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.42/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$910,649 compared to US\$2.28 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$221.02/mt last week to US\$223.64/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$209.41/mt last week to US\$203.39/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$171.29/mt and US\$147.87/mt last week to US\$173.36/mt and US\$150.15/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$330.87/mt and US\$182.83/mt last week to US\$329.75/mt and US\$181.29/mt this week respectively while the US GULF price increased from US\$214.12/mt last week to US\$214.40/mt this week.

- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabean prices decreased from US\$444.87/mt, US\$401.14/mt and US\$370.22/mt last week to US\$431.78/mt, US\$390.03/mt and US\$363.39 this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$212.05/mt last week to US\$204.32/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from **USc71.75/Pound** last week to **USc70.15/Pound** this week.
