- ♣ At Mbare Musika Market, the price of potatoes, tomatoes, dried onions, carrots, cucumbers, green mealies, bananas, naartjies and green pepper went down while the price of butternuts, sweet potatoes, yams, local and imported apples went up. Prices of other commodities remained stable.
- At Bulawayo Market, the price of medium potatoes, dried onions, butternuts and cucumbers went up while the price of tomatoes, shelled roundnuts, dried maize and bananas went down. Prices of other commodities remained the same.

TOBACCO

- ♣ As at 27 March 2015, 92 430 growers had registered compared to 99 174 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 27 March 2015 stood at 13,186,610 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.38/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 16,610,981 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.98/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$31.4 million compared to US\$49.5 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$218.16/mt last week to US\$221.51/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$203.37/mt, US\$170.70/mt and US\$147.47/mt last week to US\$204.96/mt, US\$179.27/mt and US\$155.50/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT wheat prices increased from US\$315.94/mt, US\$220.55/mt and US\$187.61/mt last week to US\$322.52/mt, US\$223.58/mt and US\$190.70/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soyabeans decreased on the SAFEX from US\$413.31/mt last week to US\$399.83/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$380.47/mt and US\$354.57/mt last week to US\$389.39/mt and US\$359.57/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from US\$193.09/mt last week to US\$207.98/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc69.15/Pound last week to USc69.95/Pound this week.
