Prices of other commodities remained stable.
- ♣ At Bulawayo Market, the price of tomatoes, dried onions, cabbages, unshelled groundnuts and dried maize went down while the price of carrots, cucumbers, green mealies and bananas went up. Prices of other commodities remained the same.

## **TOBACCO**

- As at 24 April 2015, 94 271 growers had registered compared to 100 925 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 24 April 2015 stood at 55,742,706 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.83/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 60,473,834 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.17/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$157.5 million compared to US\$191.6 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$212.62/mt last week to US\$209.97/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$198.92/mt, US\$175.63/mt and US\$149.44/mt last week to US\$193.63/mt, US\$172.77/mt and US\$146.61/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX and CBOT wheat prices increased from U\$\$309.88/mt and U\$\$181.66/mt last week to U\$\$310.62/mt and U\$\$183.20/mt this week respectively while the U\$ GULF market price decreased from U\$\$207.60/mt last week to U\$\$207.14/mt this week.
- The price of soyabeans decreased on the SAFEX from US\$393.36/mt last week to US\$392.97/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$383.32/mt and US\$355.89/mt last week to US\$383.97/mt and US\$356.56/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from **US\$215.95/mt** last week to **US\$212.42/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc69.95/Pound last week to USc69.75/Pound this week.
