TOBACCO

- As at 8 May 2015, 96 025 growers had registered compared to 103 165 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 8 May 2015 stood at 89,302,427 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.90/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 92,710,198 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.21/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$258.7 million compared to US\$297.4 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$217.62/mt last week to US\$233.16/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$195.12/mt last week to US\$201.68/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices decreased from US\$169.42/mt and US\$144.25/mt last week to US\$167.35/mt and US\$140.15/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT wheat prices increased from US\$316.79/mt, US\$191.71/mt and US\$174.75/mt last week to US\$321.80/mt, US\$196.21/mt and US\$176.73/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabeans prices decreased from US\$397.85/mt,
 US\$394.25/mt and US\$363.90/mt last week to US\$392.76/mt, US\$385.16/mt
 and US\$358.25/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from US\$215.05/mt last week to US\$218.86/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc73.10/Pound last week to USc73.35/Pound this week.
