♣ The average price per kilogramme for commercial, economy, manufacturing, weaner heifers, weaner steers, long weaner heifers, long weaner steers and feeder steers went up while the average price for bulling heifers and communal weaner steers went down.

#### **TOBACCO**

- As at 29 May 2015, 97 014 growers had registered compared to 105 000 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 29 May 2015 stood at 135,785,874 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 146,204,476 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.18/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$399.4 million compared to US\$465.5 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$237.17/mt last week to US\$223.18/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$205.67/mt, US\$165.48/mt and US\$141.73/mt last week to US\$196.11/mt, US\$161.15/mt and US\$137.55/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT wheat prices decreased from US\$321.76/mt,
  US\$211.46/mt and US\$188.49/mt last week to US\$318.38/mt, US\$204.02/mt
  and US\$179.16/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabeans prices decreased from **US\$387.89/mt**, **US\$374.87/mt** and **US\$345.83/mt** last week to **US\$379.88/mt**, **US\$370.55/mt** and **US\$340.61/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$221.85/mt last week to US\$220.19/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc72.35/Pound last week to USc71.05/Pound this week.
