#### **TOBACCO**

- ♣ As at 12 June 2015, 97 286 growers had registered compared to 105 984 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 12 June 2015 stood at 156,907,711 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.95/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 173,204,140 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.18/kg same time last year.
- → This realised total revenue amounting to US\$463.6 million compared to US\$550.7 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$221.35/mt last week to US\$229.65/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$194.74/mt last week to US\$200.40/mt this week. The US GULF and CBOT market prices decreased from US\$164.50/mt and US\$141.33/mt last week to US\$163.02/mt and US\$140.62/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX and US GULF wheat price decreased from US\$317.44/mt and US\$208.15/mt last week to US\$312.09/mt and US\$200.62/mt this week respectively. The CBOT price however marginally increased from and US\$188.27/mt last week to US\$188.64/mt this week.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabean prices increased from U\$\$387.12/mt,
   U\$\$375.06/mt and U\$\$345.61/mt last week to U\$\$389.20/mt, U\$\$378.09/mt
   and U\$\$348.84/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from US\$214.34/mt last week to US\$215.95/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc74.10/Pound last week to USc72.80/Pound this week.
