TOBACCO

- As at 26 June 2015, 97 452 growers had registered compared to 106 326 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 26 June 2015 stood at 172,337,810 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.96/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 190,162,094 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.18/kg same time last year.
- → This realised total revenue amounting to US\$509.6 million compared to US\$604.7 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$244.83/mt last week to US\$248.22/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$212.23/mt last week to US\$211.97/mt this week, while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$165.78/mt and US\$141.41/mt last week to US\$169.22/mt and US\$144.25/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$314.86/mt, US\$192.44/mt and US\$180.48/mt last week to US\$321.06/mt, US\$202.64/mt and US\$190.33/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabean prices increased from US\$396.14/mt,
 US\$387.27/mt and US\$356.04/mt last week to US\$400.58/mt, US\$391.50/mt
 and US\$360.67/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from US\$229.47/mt last week to US\$239.88/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc71.85/Pound last week to USc71.25/Pound this week.
