TOBACCO

- As at 03 July 2015, 97 616 growers have registered compared to 106 372 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 03 July 2015 stood at 178,879,945 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 196,648,962 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.18/kg same time last year.
- → This realised total revenue amounting to US\$525.8 million compared to US\$625.2 million achieved same time last year.

- ♣ The cotton buying season began on 15 June 2015.
- **♣** Eight merchants are purchasing seed cotton.
- Companies are giving farmers an advance payment of US\$0.30/kg pending grading at the ginning depots.
- Total seed cotton seasonal sales as at 3 July 2015 stood at **5 469 309 kg** compared to **30 548 662 kg** sold at the same time last year

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$248.22/mt last week to US\$243.84/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$211.97/mt, US\$166.22/mt and US\$144.25/mt last week to US\$215.39/mt, US\$186.85/mt and US\$162.83/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from US\$321.06/mt last week to US\$316.05/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$202.64/mt and US\$190.33/mt last week to US\$230.75/mt and US\$215.83/mt this week respectively.

- The SAFEX soyabean prices decreased from US\$400.58/mt last week to US\$382.49/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$391.50/mt and US\$360.67/mt last week to US\$414.09/mt and US\$383.60/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX from **US\$239.88/mt** last week to **US\$247.16/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc71.25/Pound last week to USc74.40/Pound this week.
