TOBACCO

- As at 10 July 2015, 97 616 growers had registered compared to 106 372 who had registered same time last year.
- ➡ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 10 July 2015 stood at 184,333,775 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.93/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 203,038,606 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.17/kg same time last year.
- → This realised total revenue amounting to US\$540.7 million compared to US\$644.2 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$243.84/mt last week to **US\$259.38/mt** this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$215.39/mt and US\$162.83/mt last week to US\$228.17/mt, and US\$163.85/mt respectively, while the US GULF market price decreased from **US\$186.85/mt** last week to **US\$185.18/mt** this week.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX from US\$316.05/mt last week to US\$316.44/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices decreased from US\$230.75/mt and US\$215.83/mt last week to US\$223.40/mt and **US\$210.24/mt** this week respectively.
- The SAFEX soyabean price increased from US\$382.49/mt last week to **US\$387.47/mt** this week while the US GULF and CBOT market prices decreased

from US\$414.09/mt and US\$383.60/mt last week to US\$398.39/mt and US\$369.71/mt this week respectively.

- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$247.16/mt last week to US\$243.42/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from **USc74.40/Pound** last week to **USc72.25/Pound** this week.
