TOBACCO

- → As at 17 July 2015, 97 616 growers had registered compared to 106 372 who had registered same time last year.
- ➡ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 17 July 2015 stood at 189,068,285 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.93/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 206,565,040 kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.17/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realised total revenue amounting to US\$554.05 million compared to US\$655.3 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$259.38/mt last week to US\$257.20/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$228.17/mt last week to US\$225.74/mt, while the US GULF and CBOT market prices increased from US\$185.18/mt and US\$163.85 last week to US\$188.33/mt and US\$169.05/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$316.44/mt, US\$223.40/mt and US\$210.24/mt last week to US\$316.17/mt, US\$215.22/mt and US\$208.19/mt this week respectively.
- The SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT soyabean market prices increased from US\$387.47/mt, US\$398.39/mt and US\$369.71/mt last week to US\$395.10/mt, US\$404.36/mt and US\$376.62/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$243.42/mt last week to US\$241.35/mt this week.
