TOBACCO

- As at 31 July 2015, 97 616 growers have registered compared to 106 372 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 31 July 2015 stood at 194.1 million kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 211.2 million kgs sold at an average price of US\$3.17/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$571.5 million compared to US\$670.1 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$248.59/mt last week to US\$249.33/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT from US\$218.91/mt, US\$177.20/mt and US\$158.50/mt last week to US\$213.73/mt, US\$165.97/mt and US\$146.92/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$321.72/mt and US\$192.63/mt last week to US\$312.16/mt and US\$182.39/mt this week respectively while it increased on the US GULF from US\$192.63/mt last week to US\$197.31/mt this week.
- The price of soyabeans increased on the SAFEX from US\$392.12/mt last week to US\$392.78/mt this week while the US GULF and CBOT market soyabeans prices decreased from US\$403.90/mt and US\$375/mt last week to US\$394.16/mt and US\$363.83/mt this week respectively.

•	The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from US\$249.40/mt last week to US\$239.21/mt this week.
•	Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc71.30/Pound last week to USc72.10/Pound this week.
