- → At Mbare Musika Market, the price of cabbages, rape, shelled groundnuts, carrots, cucumbers, imported apples, sugar beans, bananas and oranges went up while the prices tomatoes, dried onions, butternuts, unshelled groundnuts, shelled roundnuts and green mealies went down. Prices of other commodities remained stable.
- ♣ At Bulawayo Market, the price of tomatoes, dried onions, sugar beans, green mealies, imported apples, oranges and green paper went up while the price of

potatoes, cabbages, rape, unshelled groundnuts, carrots, cucumbers, bananas and naartjies. Prices of other commodities remained stable.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$229.65/mt last week to US\$228.38/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$210.52/mt, US\$164.79/mt and US\$136.36/mt last week to US\$210.63/mt, US\$165.48/mt and US\$149.79/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from US\$308.68/mt last week to US\$299.12/mt while the price increased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US188.31/mt and US\$171.96/mt last week to US\$200.25/mt and US\$180.03/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soybeans decreased on the SAFEX, CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$395.51/mt, US\$359.49/mt and US\$324.96/mt last week to US\$381.85/mt, US\$351.17/mt and US\$316.58/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from **US\$223.69/mt** last week to **US\$222.38/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc69.35/Pound last week to USc66.40/Pound this week.
