- ♣ At Bulawayo Market, the price of potatoes, cabbages, rape, sugar beans, unshelled groundnuts, carrots and oranges went up while the price of tomatoes, sweet potatoes, apples, bananas and green pepper went down. Prices of other commodities remained stable.

- White maize price on the SAFEX decreased from US\$237.85/mt last week to US\$230.02/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$214.76/mt last week to US\$211.18/mt while the price increased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$167.25/mt and US\$149.21/mt last week to US\$172.28/mt and US\$149.86/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$314.17/mt, US\$204.98/mt and US\$186.73/mt last week to US\$310.52/mt, US\$203.83/mt and US\$181.73/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soybeans increased on the SAFEX market from US\$412.17/mt last week to US\$413.54/mt this week but decreased on the US Gulf and CBOT markets from US\$363.57/mt and US\$334.51/mt last week to US\$358.15/mt and US\$332.60/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX from **US\$231.53/mt** last week to **US\$223.69/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc70.45/Pound to USc70.85/Pound last week this week.
