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Industry Update

U.S. 2015/16 Wheat Export Projections fall to 22 million Metric Tons

The United States 2015/16 wheat export projections haven reduced to 22 million tons as the U.S. continues to lose market share in global wheat trade. The 22 million tons export projection is the lowest since 1971/72 when the U.S wheat exports totaled 16 million tons. However, world wheat trade is projected to be slightly higher due to higher exports in Canada, EU, Brazil, and India.

South Africa introduces ZAR 958 levy on red meat imports.

The South African government has introduced a ZAR 958 levy per consignment of red meat imported into the country. The levy is with effect from $1^{\rm st}$ November 2015 and is aimed at funding red meat research and development, production development, consumer communication and education among others.




Wheat

Highlights

- Zambia's 2015/2016 wheat production is estimated at 309,100 Mt. A recent study on the Nation wheat consumption requirement pegged Zambia's 2015wheat consumption at 387,193 Mt. However, the Minister of Agriculture, Hon Given Lubinda assured the Union on Friday 13th November 2015 that he would not allow any imports to cover the short fall until all the 300,000Mt of the new crop have been moped out of the market.
- The November USDA report on global wheat supplies for 2015/16 are lowered 0.2 million tons, in comparison to the October estimates, on decreased beginning stocks partially offset by a small production increase. A 2.0-million-ton increase for EU production is partially offset by a 1.0-million-ton reduction for Australia and a 0.5-million-ton decrease for Russia. The global wheat crop for 2015/16 is now projected at 733.0 million tons, a third consecutive record.

Price trends

The Safex international soft red wheat averaged US \$ 202.04/ton in the week ending 13th November 2015 compared to US\$210.91/ton in the previous week. All prices are fob US gulf.


Soya Beans

Highlights

 South Africa's soya prices increased marginally by \$3.49 last Friday to close the week at \$396.57. The increase was largely due to higher parity prices which were supported by a weak South African Rand.



- USDA has reported that global soybean production is projected at 321.0 million tons, up 0.5 million, with the larger U.S. crop offsetting reductions by India, South Africa, and Uruguay. The Indian soybean crop is reduced 1.5 million tons to 9.5 million on lower projected yields.
- Soybeans offer prices by traders captured by the ZNFU 4455 price information system were averaging ZMW4, 200/ton in the week ending 16th November, 2015.



Maize


Highlights

- The Northern parts of Zambia has received sufficient rains to enable farmers start their farming activities for the 2015/2016 season. Unfortunately, some small scale farmers who supplied maize to FRA have not yet been paid, and have difficulties to purchase inputs for their agricultural activities.
- USDA reports that global coarse grain production for 2015/16 is raised 2.3 million tons
 with the largest increase for U.S. corn. Maize production is also increased for Argentina
 and Brazil, but lowered for Ukraine, South Africa, India, and EU. This brings global corn
 production projection to 974.8 million tons for the 2015/16 season.
- Indicative local offer prices were averaging ZMW1,650/MT with the highest offer pegged at ZMW2,100/MT on the ZNFU market price information system.







Cotton

Highlights


• This month's USDA report forecast a decrease in the 2015/16 world cotton production and consumption. The global production figure was lowered by more than one million bales for the second consecutive month. Global cotton production now stands at 22.998 million tons, down from the previous month's estimate of 23.380 million tons.



• Cotton prices on the New York market were hovering around US\$0.681/ton (≈ US\$1.49/ton) while Cotlook prices were pegged at US\$ 0.6885/ton (≈ US\$1.51/ton)

Crude oil

• Brent crude oil prices increased marginally on 16th November 2015 by 0.3% to settle at US\$44.68 from US\$47.5 recorded last week.



Beef

- USDA's November World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates projected U.S. meat production would increase by 2.9% in 2016 with pork up 1.7%, beef up 4.8%, broilers up 1.9% and turkey up 7.9%. The increase in meat supply is likely to result in lower international meat prices.
- According to the ZNFU market price information system, local dressed weight beef offer prices were averaging ZMW19/kg in Lusaka during the week ending 13th November 2015. The graph below shows local beef price trends.
