


Wheat

Highlights

Grain SA has indicated that South Africa's wheat output is likely to drop by 2.7% this season due to the country's worst drought in 23 years. Last month the Crop Estimates Committee in South Africa predicted that wheat production for the country would tumble to 1.54 million metric tons in the 2015/2016 season.

Soya Beans


Highlights





 Brent crude oil prices increased marginally on 24th November 2015 by 2.2% to settle at US\$45.80 from US\$44.68 recorded last week.


