

Weather Forecast

The table below summarizes the weather forecast for some selected towns for the period 30th March to 7th April, 2016. All the selected districts are forecast to have general decrease in rain activity. Upper average temperatures are expected to fall.



TOWN	WEATHER SUMMARY
Ndola	 Light and normal rains forecast for 3rd and 4th April respectively. The rest of the period is forecast to have no rain activities. Clear to cloudy sky is the forecast for this period. Average daily Temps: 17-27°C
Mkushi	 Normal rains are forecast for 3rd and 4th April. The rest of the period is forecast to be partly cloudy to cloudy with no chance of rains. Average daily Temps:16-27°C
Kabwe	 Normal rains forecast for 3rd, 4th and 5th April. Clear to cloudy sky with no rains is expected for the rest of the period. Average daily Temps: 16-28°C
Lusaka	 Normal rains forecast for 3rd March of 1.3mm while heavy rain of about 11mm is expected on 4th march. The rest of days are forecast to have no rain activities. However, the sky is expected to be clear to partly cloudy. Average daily Temps: 17-27°C

Mazabuka	 Light rain is forecast for 30th, March normal rains for 4th April. The rest of the period is expected to have no rain activities (31st March -3rd April and 5th-7th April) Average daily Temps: 18-29°C.
Choma	Normal rain is forecast for 4 th April. Clear sky for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd April whereas 30 th , 31 st March, 5 th ,6 th and 7 th are forecast to be partly cloudy to cloudy.
Livingstone	 Average daily Temps: 16 -26°C Light rain is forecast for 3rd, normal rains for 4th and heavy rains expected on 5th April. The rest of the days are forecast to have no rain activities. Average daily Temps: 18-30°C
Mongu	Normal rain is forecast for 30 th March, 4 th and 5 th April whereas the rest of the period under review is expected have clear to partly cloudy sky with no rains. Average daily Temps: 20-30°C.
Mansa	Light rains forecast for 30 th March, 3 rd and 6 th April whereas heavy rains forecast for 4 th and 5 th April. The rest of the period under review is forecast to have no rain activities. Average daily Temps: 19-27°C.
Kasama	 Normal rains expected for 4th and 5th April and heavy rains for 3rd April. The rest of the days are forecast to have no rain activities. Average daily Temps: 18-26C.
Solwezi	 Heavy rain is forecast for 30th March, 4rd and 5th April. The rest of the period is forecast to have no rain activities. Average daily Temps: 18-27°C.
Chipata	 Normal rains forecast for 1st, 2nd and 4th April, while the rest of the period under review is forecast to have no rain activities. Average daily Temps: 18-27°C.


Wheat

Highlights

- Canada's 2015/17 wheat plantings are forecast to drop by about 2 percent as some of the wheat area is substituted for oilseeds and other pulses in search for more returns. Exports are also forecast to fall by about 9 percent. International wheat prices have been on a general descent over the last two years.
- CME wheat futures prices for May 2016 opened trading at US\$173.06/MT on 29th March 2016.
- Local Trader wheat offer prices on the local scene were still in the range of U\$420-U\$433/MT last week.

Price trends

The Safex international soft red and hard red wheat prices averaged US \$ 189.2/MT and US\$ 236.87/MT during the week ending 24th March respectively. All prices are fob gulf. The graphs below show international price trends for soft and hard red wheat:














Soya Beans

Highlights

- As the gap between soya beans oil and palm oil narrows, the likelihood of soya oil taking part of
 the palm market share is also increasing. Palm oil prices have been on the rise since August last
 year as the current El Nino is expected to reduce the Malaysian palm harvest by about 2 million
 tons for the year ending September 2016.
- CME Soya futures price for May 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$333.71/MT on 29th March 2016.
- Local Soya beans spot prices were hovering around ZMW5, 900-6,400/MT (≈US\$533-550/ton) last week according to information captured on the ZNFU market price information system.





International spot prices for US No. 2 yellow soya beans on Safex averaged US348.39\$/MT in the week ending 24th March 2016, 9% below the average price of US\$381.37/MT recorded in the previous week. Prices are fob gulf.

Maize


Highlights

- Kenya, last month, approved for environmental release of insect resistant maize (Bt maize) for national trials. This is with the aim of combating stem borers which are quoted to reduce the Kenyan maize crop by about 13 percent annually. Kenya had imposed a ban of GM organisms import in November 2012 with a view to safeguard public health.
- The CME Corn futures price for March 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$145.82/MT on 29th March 2016.
- Local maize offer prices seem to have stabilised over the last two weeks in the range of ZMW 2,700-3,400/MT (≈US\$240-300/ton).









Crude oil

- Local supply of fuel seems to have stabilized over the last week in Lusaka and Copperbelt provinces.
- By 10:45 CAT on 29th March 2016, the Brent futures price was US\$39.42/barrel while the spot price closed Thursday's trading session at US\$40.06/barrel.



• The Dubai Mercantile exchange crude oil marker price for May 2016 delivery was settled at US\$37.35/barrel on 29th March, down from the settlement price of US\$38.29/ barrel on 18th March 2016.

Beef


Highlights

- The Namibian Meat board has set the cattle on any transaction (excluding slaughter) for levy determination during the financial year beginning 1st April 2016 at ZAR 4263 (approx. ZMW3,200). Cattle for slaughter will on the other hand be valued at ZAR 6,584. Standard values are only used where livestock transactions cannot be verified, for example export of livestock, otherwise the relevant transaction value applies as at auctions and export abattoirs and the import of livestock. The payment of levies is not subject to VAT.
- According to the Namibian Meat Board, beef prices in Namibia during the week ending 14th March 2016 for class A meat was in the range of ZAR 31.22-37.45/Kg, weaners and heifers were auctioning for ZAR18.89and ZAR17.22 per Kg respectively on 11th March 2016. Mongu had the lowest offer price while Mpika had the highest.
- Dressed weight beef prices in Zambia were still in the range of ZMW14-22/kg during the week ending 25th March 2016. This is as monitored by the ZNFU 4455 system.









AVERAGE DAY OLD CHICK PRICES


The graph below shows the price of different breeds of day old chicks in selected towns. Prices of day old chicks have been static the past two weeks with no significant changes being registered.


The graph below shows the national average price trend for day old chicks from June 2014 to March 2016. The graph also shows that the price of day old chicks has been rising since the beginning of the year but has been static the past few weeks at ZMW5.48.






AVERAGE LIVE BIRDS PRICES

The graph below shows the average live bird prices in Lusaka, Choma, Kabwe, Chipata, Mongu, Mansa, Mufulira, Chingola, Solwezi, Ndola, Kitwe and Livingstone. The average price of broiler live birds and village chickens in Livingstone went up from ZMW46.50 to ZMW47.50 that is from ZMW47.50 to ZMW57.50 representing a 2% and 21% price increase respectively.





The graph below shows the national average price trends for broilers, ex-layers and village chickens. The national average price for broilers, ex-layers and village chickens during the course of the week was ZMW43.04, ZMW35.82 and ZMW57.65 respectively.


AVERAGE EGG PRICES

The graph below shows average retail prices of table eggs in selected towns around the country. The average price for a tray of eggs in Mufulira went up from ZMW30 to ZMW32 representing a 6.7% price increase while the average price for a tray of eggs in Livingstone also rose from ZMW28 to ZMW28.5 representing a 1.7% price increase.










The graph below shows the price trend for a tray of eggs from mid-June 2014 to March 2016. The graph shows that the price of eggs has reached a new high since June 2014 at ZMW29.19. This price increase has been caused by a general increase in the cost of producing eggs.



AVERAGE WHOLE DRESSED CHICKEN PRICES


Graph 1 shows average prices of whole frozen chickens in the three chain stores around Lusaka. Pick n' Pay has the lowest average price of frozen whole chicken at ZMW24.69 with the lowest going at ZMW23.5 and the highest going for ZMW25.49. On the other hand, Spar has the highest average price at ZMW29.07 with the lowest and highest going for ZMW27 and ZMW30.10 respectively. In Shoprite, the average price is ZMW25.62 with the lowest going for ZMW21.49 and the highest going for ZMW28.49.


The graph below shows the average price trend for whole frozen chicken in Lusaka from June 2014 – March 2016. The average price for frozen whole chickens in Lusaka went up during the course of the week to ZMW26.46 per kilogram.






AVERAGE FEED PRICES

The graph below shows average feed prices in selected towns. There have been some upward price adjustments on some brands of poultry stock feeds the past two weeks. This has been caused by the high cost of production.
