


Wheat


Highlights

- On the local scene, some farmers are still holding on to wheat as they are not receiving any purchase offers. This does not only increase their storage costs but also raises concern on where they will store their maize and soya beans crop which they are about to harvest.
- CME wheat futures prices for May 2016 opened trading at US\$164.3MT on 12th April 2016.

Price trends

The Safex international soft red and hard red wheat prices averaged US\$ 191.36/MT and US\$ 188.64/MT during the week ending 8th April respectively. All prices are fob gulf. The graphs below show international price trends for soft and hard red wheat:






Soya Beans

Highlights

- The Argentine government is anticipated to reduce its export taxes on soya beans grain and soya oils and meals by five percent from the current 30% for beans and 27% for oils and meals. The country last December completely eliminated export taxes on its maize, wheat and sunflower thereby increasing the competitiveness of the crops on the international markets.
- Meanwhile, Brazil's soya beans exports in March 2016 were recorded at 8.3million tons, 50% more than the exports recorded in March 2015. China has been the country's single largest importer of the commodity.
- CME Soya futures price for May 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$340.76/MT on 12th April 2016.
- Local Soya beans spot prices were still hovering around ZMW5, 900-6,400/MT last week according to information captured on the ZNFU market price information system.





Maize


Highlights

- The issuance of permits for the importation of about 140,000MT of mealie meal by the Zimbabwean government has stirred an uproar from the millers. According to the Commercial Farmers Union of Zimbabwe, the country of origin for most of the imports, as captured on the permits, was South Africa.
- On the local scene, the maize market players are anxiously awaiting the next signal from government as the one week maize and maize export ban comes to expiration on 12th April 2016.
- The CME Corn futures price for March 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$140.54/MT on 12th April 2016.
- The offer price on the ZNFU market information system was in the range of ZMW 1,300/MT to ZMW 1,800/MT in the week ending 9thApril 2016.









Crude oil

International crude oil prices showed some appreciation end of last week and into the fresh week.
 By 16:45 CAT on 11th April 2016, the Brent futures price was US\$42.39/barrel while the spot price closed Friday's trading session at US\$41.89/barrel.



• The Dubai Mercantile exchange crude oil marker price for June 2016 delivery was settled at US\$38.48/barrel on 8th April 2016, down from the settlement price of US\$35.5/ barrel on 1st April 2016.



Beef

Highlights

- Namibian grade A beef prices in abattoirs, captured by the Namibian Meat board, was trading in the range of ZAR30-37/kg during the week ending 1st April 2016. The auction price for heifers and weaners was ZAR15.83/kg and ZAR 17.85/kg respectively.
- Dressed weight beef prices in Zambia were still in the range of ZMW15-24/kg during the week ending 10th April 2016. This is as monitored by the ZNFU 4455 system.





AVERAGE DAY OLD CHICK PRICES


The graph below shows the price of different breeds of day old chicks in selected towns. Prices of day old chicks were stable during the course of the week in the towns displayed.



AVERAGE LIVE BIRDS PRICES








AVERAGE EGG PRICES



AVERAGE WHOLE DRESSED CHICKEN PRICES




Graph 1 shows average prices of whole frozen chickens in the three chain stores around Lusaka. This week, Pick n' Pay has the lowest average price for frozen whole chicken per kilogram at ZMW26.10 with the lowest going at ZMW24.90 and the highest going for ZMW27.90. Spar had the highest average price per kilogram at ZMW30.43 with the lowest and highest going for ZMW27 and ZMW34.20 respectively. On the other hand, Shoprite had the lowest average price at ZMW26.24 with the lowest going for ZMW21.49 and the highest going for ZMW28.49.




AVERAGE FEED PRICES
