


### Wheat


# **Highlights**

- Russia exported about 22.1 million tons of wheat between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015, the onset of its marketing season, and 27<sup>th</sup> April 2016, about 9 percent higher on a year-on year basis. Expectations are for the country to increase its exports further in the 2016/17 year. This will be supported by expectations of lower government purchases of the commodity due to storage limitations.
- CME wheat futures prices for July 2016 opened trading at US\$168.8MT on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2016.

### **Price trends**

The Safex international soft red and hard red wheat prices averaged US\$191.07 /MT and US\$ 191.08/MT during the week ending 6<sup>th</sup> May respectively. All prices are fob gulf. The graphs below show international price trends for soft and hard red wheat:







# Soya Beans

# **Highlights**

- The International Grain Council in its April 2016 report has intimated a bearish outlook on South America's soya beans output for the 2015/16 production year on weather concerns. The forecast 318 million tons will however be just marginally lower than last year's all-time high. A drop in Brazil, and Argentina's crop prospects, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest producers of soya beans respectively, would result in an upward movement in international prices.
- CME Soya futures price for July 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$376.84/MT on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
- According to the ZNFU market Price Information System, average national offer prices were hovering around ZMW 4,100/MT last week as shown in the graph below;





International spot prices for US No. 2 yellow soya beans on Safex averaged US\$389.80/MT in the week ending 6<sup>th</sup> May 2016, 1.6% above the average price of US\$383.67/MT recorded in the previous week. Prices are fob gulf.


# Maize

# **Highlights**

- The crop forecast results released last week reveal that about 60 percent of Zambia's maize crop will be from the northern half of the country. The maize marketable surplus in the Southern half provinces (i.e. Western, Northern Western and Southern Provinces) has risen in comparison to the previous year save for Eastern Province which is anticipated to record a 51.8 percent drop in its maize sales during the 2016/17 marketing seasons.
- The restrictions in maize movements by government are causing bottlenecks as the early maize harvesters in Mkushi try to deliver their produce to Lusaka millers. Maize movements were restricted about a month ago in an effort to curb smuggling of maize obtained from the Food Reserve Agency across borders.
- Meanwhile, the maize value chain is anxiously awaiting the announcement of the FRA maize purchase price and governments policy direction for the marketing of maize in the 2016/17 season.
- The CME Corn futures price for July 2016 delivery opened trading at US\$145.11/MT on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
- The maize average offer price on the ZNFU market information system was ZMW 1552/MT in the week ending 10<sup>th</sup> May 2016 as shown below:







# Crude oil

- Despite falling crude oil output by Canada due to raging wildfires, internal oil prices have generally been slumping due to positive supply prospects from the US.
- Brent crude oil futures prices closed trading on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2016 aroundUS\$44.23/barrel while spot prices were hovering around US\$43.77/barrel the previous day.



• The Dubai Mercantile exchange crude oil marker price for July 2016 delivery settled at US\$40.60/barrel on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2016, down from the settlement price of US\$43.96/ barrel on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016.



# Highlights

- Namibian grade A beef prices in abattoirs, captured by the Namibian Meat board, was trading in the range of ZAR31.1-37.06/kg during the week ending 9<sup>th</sup> May 2016. The auction price for heifers and weaners was ZAR15.92/kg and ZAR 16.56/kg respectively on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2016.
- Dressed weight average beef prices in Zambia was ZMW18.25/kg during the week ending 9<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
   This is as monitored by the ZNFU 4455 system.




# DAIRY UPDATES FOR THE WEEK ENDING 6th MAY 2016

## **GLOBAL WHOLE MILK POWDER PRICE TRENDS**

Price of whole milk powder on the international market slumped from **USD 2,200** on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2016 to **USD 2,012.50** on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2016 as seen below;

# AVERAGE PRICES OF FRESH MILK, UHT AND YOGURT

Average prices for dairy products remained relatively constant during the period 29<sup>th</sup> April to 6<sup>th</sup> May 2016. Notable price adjustment was that for drinking yogurt that recorded a slight increase of 3% from K4.45 to K4.59.



## **NATIONAL AVERAGE FEED PRICES**

Average dairy feed prices and that of feed ingridients have generally increased in recent months .The average price of a 25 Kg bag of maize bran increased by over 91% from K22 in May 2015 to K42 on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2016. The price of a 50kg bag of no.3 meal increased by 85%,sunflower cake by 132%,cotton cake by 99% in the same period.





## POULTRY UPDATES FOR THE WEEK ENDING 6th MAY 2016

### **AVERAGE DAY OLD CHICK PRICES**

The graph below shows the price of different breeds of day old chicks in selected town. There have been downward price adjustments in some towns, however according to industry players' sales of day old chicks have significantly slowed down and this has been attributed to the high cost of production in the poultry sector making some farmers either scale down or pull out of poultry production.







## **AVERAGE LIVE BIRDS PRICES**


The graph below shows the average live bird prices in selected towns. Prices of live birds in most towns were stable during the course of the week. However, farmers have complained that selling of birds now takes longer than it used to, thereby adding onto many challenges that farmers are already faced with. Keeping birds for longer period is a cost to the farmer resulting in tightened profit margins.




## **AVERAGE EGG PRICES**

The graph below shows average retail prices of table eggs in selected towns around the country. Over the past few weeks, egg farmers in some towns have been faced with lower demand coupled with reduced egg prices. Most of this has been said to be caused by the reduced purchasing power by consumers. Despite farm gate prices for eggs going as low as ZMW23 in Lusaka for instance, demand has been on the lower side.





The graph below shows the price trend for a tray of eggs from mid-June 2014 to May 2016. According to the graph the national average price for a tray of eggs is ZMW29.50


### **AVERAGE WHOLE DRESSED CHICKEN PRICES**

**Graph 1** shows average prices of whole frozen chickens in the three chain stores around Lusaka. Spar maintained the highest average price at ZMW30.43/kg with the lowest and highest going for ZMW27/kg and ZMW34.20/kg respectively. Pick n' Pay also maintained the lowest average price for frozen whole chicken at ZMW25.59/kg with the lowest priced chicken at ZMW24.79/kg and the highest going for ZMW27.90 per kg. On the other hand, the average price for frozen whole chicken in Shoprite was ZMW28.12 /kg with the lowest going for ZMW26.49/kg and the highest going for ZMW29.99/kg. Meanwhile the average price for fresh whole chickens in Shoprite, Pick n Pay and Spar was ZMW31.99, ZMW31.99 and ZMW28.50 per kilogram respectively. Other prices include frozen whole chicken in Zambeef outlets at ZM25.90/kg and ZMW30/kg in Melissa Supermarket.





The graph below shows the average price trend for whole frozen chicken in Lusaka from June 2014 – May 2016. The average price of frozen whole chicken in Lusaka during the course of the week was ZMW28.17/kg which is 50.57% up from the average price of ZMW17.5/kg during a similar period of 2015.






### **AVERAGE FEED PRICES**
