TOBACCO

- As at 29 April 2016, 77 235 growers had registered compared to 95 515 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 29 April 2016 stood at 30,314,377kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.69/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 17,907,441 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.51/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realised total revenue amounting to US\$81.54 million compared to US\$44.88 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$313.74/mt last week to US\$311.08/mt this week.
- The yellow maize price decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$233.55/mt, US\$173.06/mt and US\$155.35/mt last week to US\$221.17/mt, US\$170.60/mt and US\$152.36/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX market from US\$323.75/mt last week to US\$325.69/mt this week while prices decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$205.30/mt and US\$185.26/mt last week to US\$195.11/mt and US\$174.68/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soyabeans decreased on the SAFEX market from U\$\$432.03/mt last week to U\$\$430.49/mt this week while prices increased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from U\$\$384.78/mt and U\$\$370.26/mt last week to U\$\$388.01/mt and U\$\$374.04/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$255.78/mt** last week to **US\$257.59/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc71.60/Pound last week to USc71.25/Pound this week.
