The average price per kilogram for choice, commercial, economy, long weaner steers, feeder steers and communal weaner steers went up while the price for manufacturing, weaner heifers, weaner steers and long weaner heifers went down.

### **TOBACCO**

- As at 03 June 2016, 80 272 growers had registered compared to 97 014 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 1 June 2016 stood at 104,830,542 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.89/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 140,473,421 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$303.06 million compared to US\$413.47 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX from US\$317.98/mt last week to US\$306.60/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$235.85/mt, US\$172.67/mt and US\$160.70/mt last week to US\$240.25/mt, US\$176.61/mt and US\$162.83/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$330.12/mt last week
  to US\$324.81/mt this week. It however, decreased on the US GULF and CBOT
  markets from US\$192.99/mt and US\$176.81/mt last week to US\$188.40/mt
  and US\$174.02/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soybeans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$477.71/mt, US\$408.12/mt and US\$396.68/mt last week to US\$487.82/mt, US\$418.04/mt and US\$404.03/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$236.35/mt** last week to **US\$235.89/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc72.95/Pound last week to USc72.05/Pound this week.
