TOBACCO

- 4 As at 15 June 2016, 80 987 growers had registered compared to 97 171 who had registered same time last year.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 15 June 2016 stood at 133,597,506 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.91/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 160,120,191kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.96/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realised total revenue amounting to US\$389 million compared to US\$474 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$319.60/mt last week to US\$324.43/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$242.96/mt, US\$184.49/mt and US\$168.18/mt last week to US\$250.49/mt, US\$188.14/mt and US\$171.80/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX and US GULF from US\$326.94/mt and US\$201.35/mt last week to US\$315.39/mt and US\$183.35/mt this week respectively, while the price increased on the CBOT market from US\$174.02/mt last week to US\$178.20/mt this week.
- The price of soyabeans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$504.04/mt, US\$432.74/mt and US\$418.21/mt last week to US\$524.56/mt, US\$445.88/mt and US\$429.67/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$248.82/mt** last week to **US\$251.14/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc74.50/Pound last week to USc72.75/Pound this week.
