TOBACCO

- 4 As at 15 July 2016, 81 649 growers had registered compared to 97 616 who had registered same time last year.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 15 July 2016 stood at 174,683,342 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 186,010,060 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.95/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realised total revenue amounting to US\$514 million compared to US\$548 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX from US\$317.07/mt last week to US\$320.82/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$229.66/mt and US\$132.04/mt last week to US\$236.34/mt and

- **US\$168.04/mt** this week respectively. However, the US GULF price decreased from **US\$159.87/mt** last week to **US\$143.93/mt** this week.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT market from US\$315.23/mt, US\$167.18/mt and US\$151.38/mt last week to US\$318.31/mt, US\$171.68/mt and US\$156.60/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$493.88/mt, US\$415.20/mt and US\$387.35/mt last week to US\$512.31/mt, US\$441.93/mt and US\$414.46/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$250.34/mt last week to US\$223.62/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from **USc75.95/Pound** last week to **USc83.85/Pound** this week. The price same time last year was **USc71.75/Pound**.
