- White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from US\$260.66/mt last week to US\$271.74/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX market from US\$233.07/mt last week to US\$233.64/mt this week whilst the price decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$155.04/mt and US\$140.70/mt last week to US\$154.05/mt and US\$139.36/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$298.27/mt, US\$169.11/mt and US\$154.39/mt last week to US\$293.67/mt, US\$165.90/mt and US\$151.11/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$372.21/mt and US\$360.60/mt last week to US\$381.21/mt and US\$371.11/mt this week respectively whilst the price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$479.11/mt last week to US\$465.85/mt this week.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$247.12/mt** last week to **US\$244.42/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc80.53/Pound last week to USc78.65/Pound this week.
