- White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from US\$277.19/mt last week to US\$290.09/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$233.93/mt, US\$147.55/mt and US\$133.22/mt last week to US\$234.96/mt, US\$151.59/mt and US\$138.03/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$278.56/mt, US\$163.32/mt and US\$140.87/mt last week to US\$279.19/mt, US\$163.98/mt and US\$147.49/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$458.25/mt, US\$373.95/mt and US\$362.14 last week to US\$463.55/mt, US\$389.02/mt and US\$380.00 this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from US\$245.61/mt last week to US\$252.65/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc80.40/Pound last week to USc80.20/Pound this week.
