Made and entered in accordance with Labour Act [Chapter 28:01], as amended from time to time between the Zimbabwe Agricultural Employers Organisation, Zimbabwe Commercial Farmers Union, Zimbabwe Farmers Union, Commercial Farmers Union, Agro employer representatives (hereinafter referred to as "the employers or employers' organisation") of the one part, and the General Agriculture and Plantation Workers' Union of Zimbabwe; Horticulture, General Agriculture and Plantation Workers' Union of Zimbabwe, as the other part (hereinafter referred to as the "employees" or "the trade unions"), of the other party being parties to the National Employment Council for the Agricultural Industry of Zimbabwe to further amend the Collective Bargaining Agreement, published in Statutory Instrument 116 of 2014.
