- ♣ At Bulawayo Market, the price of tomatoes and cucumbers went up while the price of medium and large potatoes went down. The prices of other commodities remained stable.

### **TOBACCO**

- As at 20 April 2017, 93,698 growers had registered compared to 76,310 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 19 April 2017 stood at 52,481,861 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.69/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 39,121,864 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.61/kg same time last year.
- → This realised total revenue amounting to US\$141.2 million compared to US\$107.8 million achieved same time last year.

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$152.69/mt** last week to **US\$140.62/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$157.56/mt, US\$158.78/mt and US\$145.28/mt last week to US\$148.06/mt, US\$154.35/mt and US\$140.78/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX markets from US\$323.99/mt last week to US\$336.75/mt this week while it decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$177.38/mt and US\$159.17/mt last week to US\$166.91/mt and US\$149.25/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX market from US\$353.58/mt last week to US\$357.25/mt this week while on the CBOT market it decreased from US\$348.18/mt last week to US\$347.81/mt this week. The price on the US GULF remained unchanged at US\$357.97/mt.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$219.19/mt** last week to **US\$225.51/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from US\$86.35/Pound last week to USc83.55/Pound this week.
