The average price per kilogram for commercial, bulling heifers, cows & calves, long weaner heifers, communal weaner steers went down whilst the average price for economy, manufacturing, weaner heifers, weaner steers, long weaner steers and feeder steers went up.

## TOBACCO

- As at 01 June 2017, 98,463 growers had registered compared to 80,272 who had registered same time last year.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 01 June 2017 stood at 144,282,708 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.88/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 127,459,525 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.91/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$415.7 million compared to US\$370.3 million achieved same time last year.


#### **SEED COTTON**

 White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$136.68/mt last week US\$134.22/mt to this week.

- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$143.36/mt, US\$145.43/mt and US\$158.59/mt last week to US\$144.74/mt, US\$146.75/mt and US\$158.78/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the US GULF market from US\$173.79/mt last week to US\$174.81/mt this week, while it decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$342.67/mt and US\$157.77/mt last week to US\$341.15/mt and US\$157.70/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from \$347.20/mt, US\$361.83/mt and US\$348.40/mt last week to US\$347.04/mt, US\$349.98/mt and US\$336.57/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from US\$214.89/mt last week to US\$218.73/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc87.00/Pound last week to US\$86.95/Pound this week.
