The average price per kilogram for commercial, weaner heifers, bulling heifers, cows & calves, long weaner heifers and communal weaner steers went up whilst the average price for economy and weaner steers went down.

## TOBACCO

- As at 07 June 2017, 98,579 growers had registered compared to 80,606 who had registered same time last year.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 07 June 2017 stood at 152,136,540 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.90/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 140,519,257 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.92/kg same time last year.
- This realised total revenue amounting to US\$440,9 million compared to US\$410,8 million achieved same time last year.

- **4** Total national seed cotton seasonal sales as at 9 June 2017 stood at **3 634 581 kgs** compared to no intake during the same time last year.



• White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$134.22/mt** last week to **US\$139.40/mt** this week.

- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$144.74/mt, US\$146.75/mt and US\$158.78/mt last week to US\$149.07/mt, US\$151.41/mt and US\$161.84/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$341.15/mt, US\$174.89/mt and US\$157.70/mt last week hile it decreased to US\$350.62/mt, US\$179.95/mt and US\$163.36/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$347.04/mt, US\$349.98/mt and US\$336.57/mt last week to US\$352.96/mt, US\$354.66/mt and US\$341.93/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$218.73/mt** last week to **US\$218.07/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc86.95/Pound last week to US\$86.15/Pound this week.
