- ♣ At Mbare Musika, the price of tomatoes, onions, butternuts, roundnuts, carrots and cucumbers went up whilst the price of rape, sugar beans, sweet potatoes, yams, apples, bananas, naartjies and oranges went down. Prices of commodities remained stable.
- → At Bulawayo Market, the price of medium potatoes, groundnuts, sweet potatoes, green mealies, bananas and green pepper went up while the price of large potatoes, tomatoes, cabbages, rape, sugar beans, carrots, cucumbers, imported apples, oranges and garlic went down. The prices of other commodities remained stable.

## **TOBACCO**

- ♣ As at 30 June 2017, 98,852 growers had registered compared to 81,445 who had registered same time last year.
- → Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 30 June 2017 stood at 168,492,810 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 170,743,461 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg same time last year.
- This realized total revenue amounting to US\$494.98 million compared to US\$501.20 million achieved same time last year.



- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$131.71/mt last week to US\$130.60/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$141.84/mt, US\$154.35/mt and US\$142.75/mt last week to US\$139.88/mt, US\$151.99/mt and US\$140.39/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$338.44/mt and US\$169.46/mt last to \$US326.82/mt and \$US167.99/mt this week respectively, while it increased on the US GULF market from US\$185.46/mt last week to US\$186.01/mt this week.
- The price of soya beans increased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$343.92/mt and US\$332.16/mt last week to US\$348.51/mt and US\$335.83/mt this week respectively whilst the price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$347.25/mt last week to US\$339.57/mt this week.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$208.82/mt** last week to **US\$208.66/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc82.60/Pound last week to US\$83.80/Pound this week.
