TOBACCO

- ♣ As at 13 July 2017, 98,898 growers had registered compared to 81,649 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 12 July 2017 stood at 175,931,280 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.96/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 185,416,542 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.94/kg same time last year.
- This realized total revenue amounting to US\$520.09 million compared to US\$544.88 million achieved same time last year.



- White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$136.36/mt** last week to **US\$137.92/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX from US\$146.66/mt last week to US\$148.33/mt this week. The US GULF and CBOT markets however decreased from US\$161.34/mt and US\$148.81/mt last week to US\$157.99/mt and US\$148.10/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX from US\$328.24/mt last week to US\$331.23/mt this week. The CBOT and US GULF market prices decreased from US\$217.70 and US\$197.16/mt last week to US\$210.72/mt and US\$191.95/mt, this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$346.36/mt, US\$368.99/mt and US\$354.42/mt last week to US\$350.31/mt, US\$385.16/mt and US\$373.53/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$202.85/mt** last week to **US\$205.17/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc83.65/Pound last week to US\$83.20/Pound this week.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$202.85/mt** last week to **US\$240.64/mt** this week.
