TOBACCO

- ♣ As at 3 August 2017, 98,914 growers had registered compared to 81,788 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 2 August 2017 stood at 183,166,854 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.95/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 197,723,384 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.95/kg same time last year.
- This realized total revenue amounting to US\$543.65 million compared to US\$582.42 million achieved same time last year.



- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$139.08/mt** last week to **US\$136.15/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$147.05/mt, US\$153.76/mt and US\$147.32 last week to US\$144.16/mt, US\$151.30/mt and US\$143.06/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$343.30/mt, US\$189.87/mt and US\$176.22/mt last week to US\$338.32/mt, US\$183.26/mt and US\$168.14/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$362.07/mt, US\$383.87/mt and US\$365.45/mt last week to US\$344.99/mt, US\$367.25/mt and US\$349.21/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$242.91/mt** last week to **US\$237.28/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc85.00/Pound last week to US\$80.45/Pound this week.
