- At Bulawayo Market, the price of tomatoes, cucumbers and green pepper increased while the price of butternuts and shelled groundnuts decreased. The prices of other commodities remained stable.

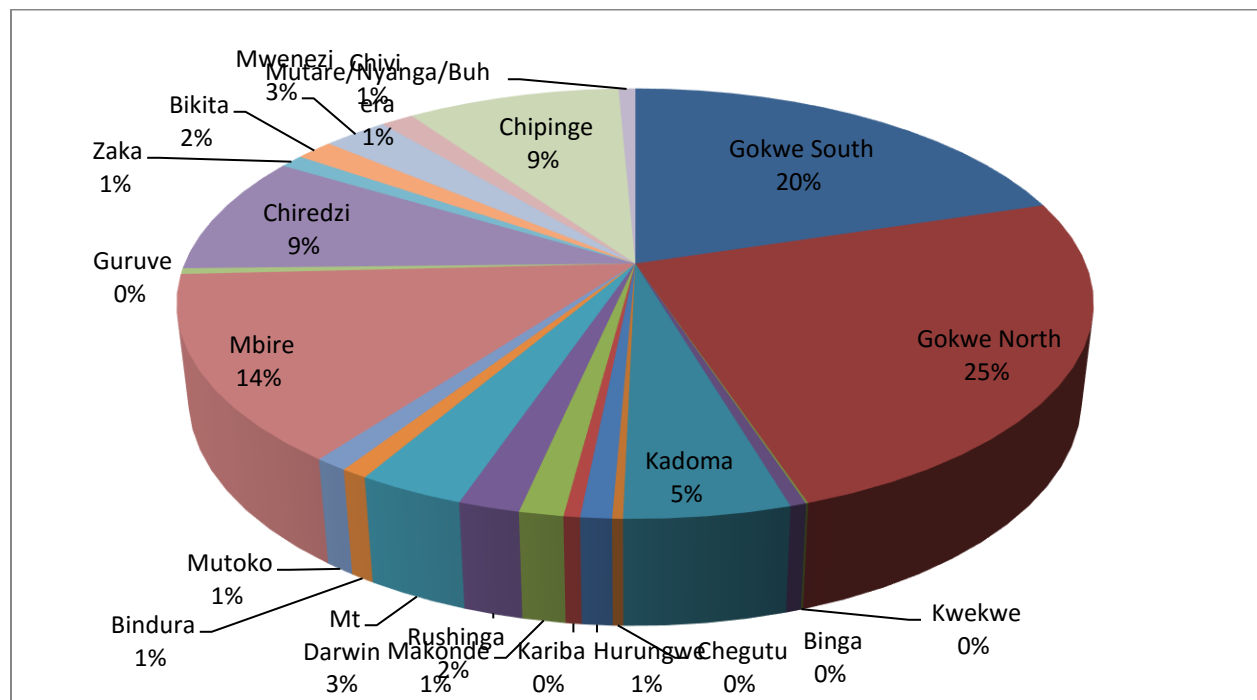

- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$135.46/mt** last week to **US\$134.70/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from **US\$144.56/mt** and **US\$138.73/mt** last week to **US\$143.43/mt** and **US\$137.08/mt** this week respectively and increased on the US GULF market from **US\$149.72/mt** last week to **US\$149.82/mt** this week.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$300.74/mt**, last week to **US\$302.27/mt** this week and decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$183.72/mt** and **US\$167.18/mt** last week to **US\$180.78/mt** and **US\$162.40/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$346.56/mt** **US\$371.11/mt** and **US\$352.51/mt** last week to **US\$342.48/mt**, **US\$365.69/mt** and **US\$352.09/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$196.15/mt** last week to **US\$190.76/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from **US\$79.05/Pound** last week to **US\$78.65/Pound** this week.
