- At Mbare Musika the price of potatoes, dried onions, sugar beans, shelled groundnuts, tomatoes, butternuts, carrots, cucumbers, imported apples, naartjies and green pepper increased while the price of unshelled groundnuts, roundnuts, sweet potatoes, dried maize, green mealies and local apples decreased . The prices of other commodities remained constant.
- At Bulawayo CBD Market, the price of tomatoes, large potatoes, onions, rape, carrots, and imported apples increased while the price of bananas and green pepper decreased. The price of other commodities remained stable.

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$156.29/mt** last week to **US\$159.06/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT market from **US\$163.12/mt, US\$172.97/mt and US\$149.05/mt** last week to **US\$166.11/mt, US\$175.23/mt and US\$149.28/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$304.73/mt** last week to **US\$305.62/mt** and decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$212.38/mt and US\$185.70/mt** last week to **US\$204.75/mt and US\$181.14/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from **US\$399.24/mt and US\$388.52mt** last week to **US\$390.69/mt and US\$387.64** and increased on the US GULF from **US\$404.54/mt** last week to **US\$406.65/mt** this week.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$261.60/mt** last week to **US\$264.26/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from **US\$91.20/Pound** last week to **US\$92.20/Pound** this week.
