- ♣ At Mbare Musika, the price of large potatoes, butternuts, sugar beans, sweet potatoes, yams, local apples, bananas and garlic increased while the price of onions, carrots and green pepper decreased. The prices of other commodities remained constant.
- → At Bulawayo CBD Market, the price of rape, green pepper, garlic, oranges, bananas, apples (local), sweet potatoes, shelled roundnuts and dried onions increased while the price of tomatoes, imported apples, carrots, unshelled roundnuts and medium potatoes decreased.

#### **TOBACCO**

- As at 20 June 2018, 145,115 growers had registered compared to 98,744 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 20 June 2018 stood at 203,310,795kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.91/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 158,541,414kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.91/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realized total revenue amounting to US\$592.3 million compared to US\$461.6 million achieved same time last year.



- White maize price decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$156.44/mt last week to US\$150.29/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$164.02/mt, US\$169.81/mt and US\$148.02/mt last week to US\$157.79/mt, US\$161.54/mt and US\$139.44/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$296.97/mt, US\$211.64/mt and US\$189.74/mt last week to US\$289.52/mt, US\$201.72/mt and US\$179.38/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$331.14/mt, US\$364.12/mt and US\$343.92/mt last week to US\$316.30/mt, US\$346.49/mt and US\$326.79/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$234.85/mt** last week to **US\$226.35/mt**.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from **USc101.45/Pound** last week to **USc93.00/Pound** this week.
