- ♣ At Mbare Musika, the price of dried onions, rape or covo, dried maize, oranges and bananas increased while the price of medium potatoes, large potatoes, tomatoes, butternuts, sugar beans, sweet potatoes, carrots and green pepper decreased. The price of other commodities remained constant.
- ♣ At Bulawayo CBD Market, the price of shelled ground nuts, roundnuts, millet, cucumbers, green mealies and bananas increased while the price of medium potatoes, dried onions, butternuts, cabbages, sugar beans, sweet potatoes, oranges, garlic and green pepper decreased. The prices of other commodities remained constant.


COTTON

- White maize price increased on the SAFEX market from US\$159.11/mt last week to US\$159.41/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX markets from US\$162.76/mt last week to US\$162.90/mt this week and decreased on the CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$138.42/mt and US\$161.05/mt last week to US\$134.40/mt and US\$152.68/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX and US GULF markets from US\$284.31/mt and US\$204.02 last week to US\$294.35/mt and US\$208.24/mt this week respectively and decreased on the CBOT market from US\$181.36/mt last week to US\$176.95/mt this week.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the US GULF market from US\$312.50/mt last week to US\$307.91/mt this week and increased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$298.50/mt and US\$303.28/mt last week to US\$304.44/mt and US\$304.60/mt this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from US\$227.86/mt last week to US\$241.94/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc91.55/pound last week to USc92.15/pound this week
