- ♣ At Mbare Musika, the price of large potatoes, tomatoes, butternuts, cabbages, sugar beans, shelled groundnuts, sweet potatoes, yams, dried maize bananas, oranges, garlic and green pepper increased while the price of rape, unshelled groundnuts, roundnuts, local rice, carrots, cucumber, local apples and imported apples decreased. The price of other commodities remained constant.
- ♣ At Bulawayo CBD Market the price of large potatoes, dried onions and bananas increased while the price of tomatoes, butternuts, cabbages, cucumbers decreased. The price of other commodities remained constant


COTTON

- The price of white maize decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$162.02/mt last week to US\$161.02/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the US GULF market from US\$158.49/mt last week to US\$158.87/mt this week and decreased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$164.40/mt and US\$143.54/mt last week to US\$163.79/mt and US\$142.75/mt this week.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$300.27/mt, US\$208.61/mt and US\$188.30/mt last week to US\$299.45/mt, US\$207.97/mt and US\$187.54/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX market from US\$309.10/mt last week to US\$312.01/mt this week and decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$316.91/mt and US\$316.51/mt last week to US\$316.82/mt and US\$313.12/mt this week.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from US\$244.57/mt last week to US\$248.98/mt this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc85.95/pound last week to USc86.35/pound this week.
