- The price of white maize increased on the SAFEX market from US\$165.69/mt last week to US\$177.32/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX and US GULF from US\$165.90/mt and US\$158.49/mt last week to US\$171.47/mt and US\$159.59/mt this week respectively and decreased on the CBOT market from US\$142.36/mt last week to US\$141.88/mt this week.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX market from US\$302.01/mt last week to US\$307.46/mt this week and decreased on the CBOT and US GULF markets from US\$183.20/mt and US\$208.06/mt last week to US\$182.76/mt and US\$206.31/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX and CBOT markets from US\$328.00/mt and US\$324.44/mt last week to US\$338.26/mt and US\$327.16/mt this week respectively and decreased on the US GULF from US\$332.16/mt last week to US\$331.97/mt this week.
- The price of sorghum increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$265.61/mt** last week to **US\$270.67/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from USc85.50/pound last week to USc85.55/pound this week.
