TOBACCO

- ♣ As at 06 June 2019, 184,192 growers had registered compared to 144,905 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 06 June 2019 stood at 153,977,615 kgs sold at an average price of US\$1.84/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 177,871,002 kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.87/kg same time last year.
- ♣ This realized total revenue amounting to US\$283.85 million compared to US\$515.24 million achieved same time last year.



- The price of white maize decreased on the SAFEX market from US\$195.40/mt last week to US\$190.72/mt this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$192.11/mt, US\$191.98/mt and US\$164.80/mt last week to US\$188.97/mt, US\$183.70/mt and US\$163.22/mt this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX and US GULF markets from US\$303.56/mt and US\$214.21/mt last week to US\$302.35/mt and US210.63/mt respectively and increased on the CBOT market from US\$180.19/mt last week to US\$180.26/mt this week.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX market from U\$\$343.62/mt last week to U\$\$348.89/mt this week and decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from U\$\$343.55/mt and U\$\$320.40/mt last week to U\$\$337.76/mt and U\$\$319.52 this week respectively.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from USc80.60/Pound last week to USc80.35/Pound this week.
